ABOUT ISLAND TV

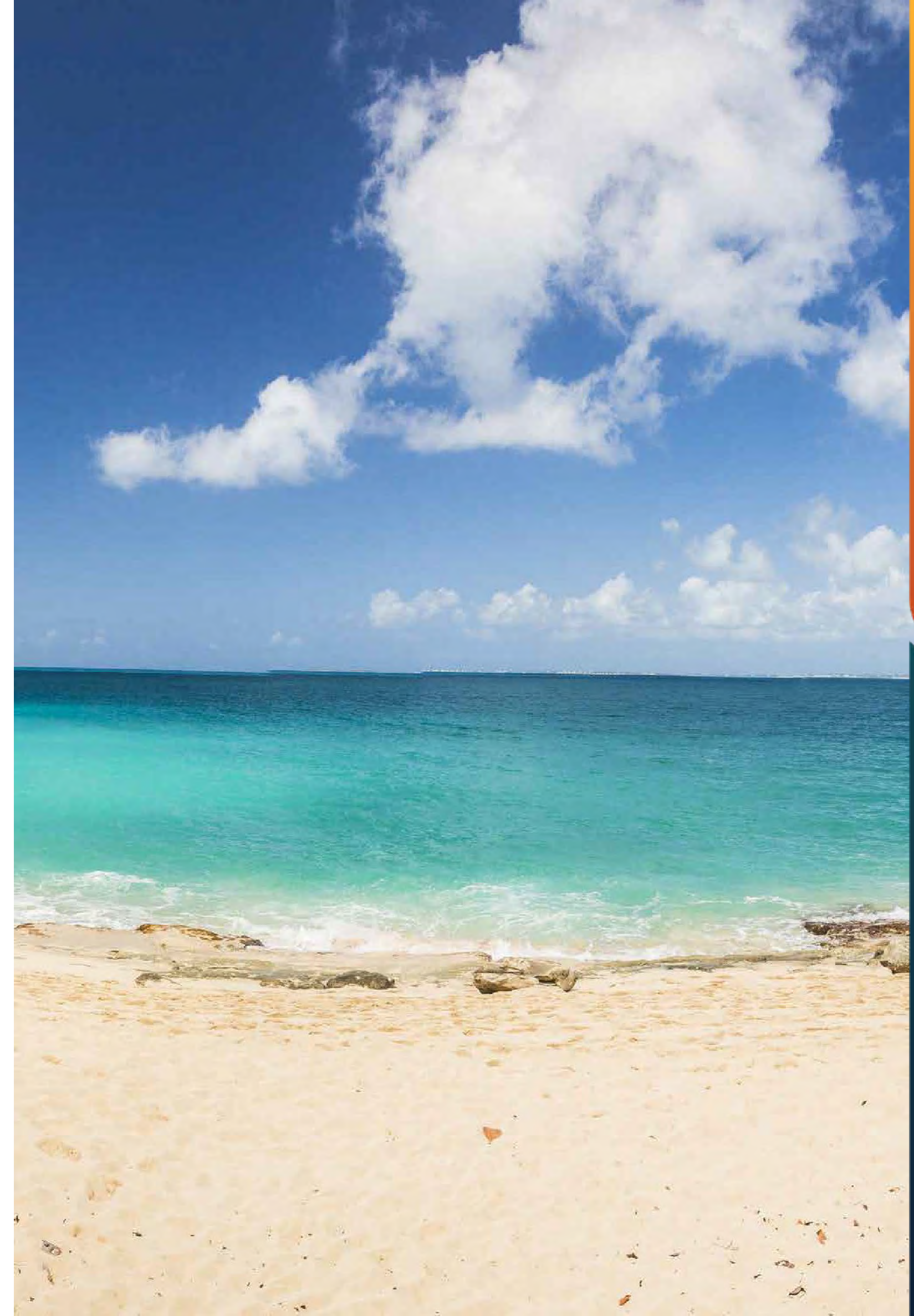
Island TV, a television network based in South Florida, serving Caribbean communities for over two decades. **Island TV** offers traditional and video-on-demand (VOD) distribution methods, and is available on cable, over-the-air, and digital platforms.

Since its inception in 1996, **Island TV** has been a vital source of information and entertainment for the Haitian diaspora throughout South Florida. Over the last few years however, the programming has widened to include the broader Caribbean community — a community with distinct cultural, linguistic, and social characteristics. The Caribbean American population is growing exponentially in the United States which creates an immediate need for them to have access to cultural and inclusive television programming.

Island TV's programming includes breaking news, politics, movies, gospel, cooking, music, faith based and talk shows. Our programs are produced in English, Haitian-Creole, and French — a unique offering.

Island TV celebrates Black history, culture, and entertainment all year. With 24 hours of programming covering news, concerts, entertainment, politics, and talk shows, **Island TV** gives its viewers a refreshing new perspective on the Caribbean culture.

We are rooted in community engagement and our work is distinctly authentic and culture-driven.

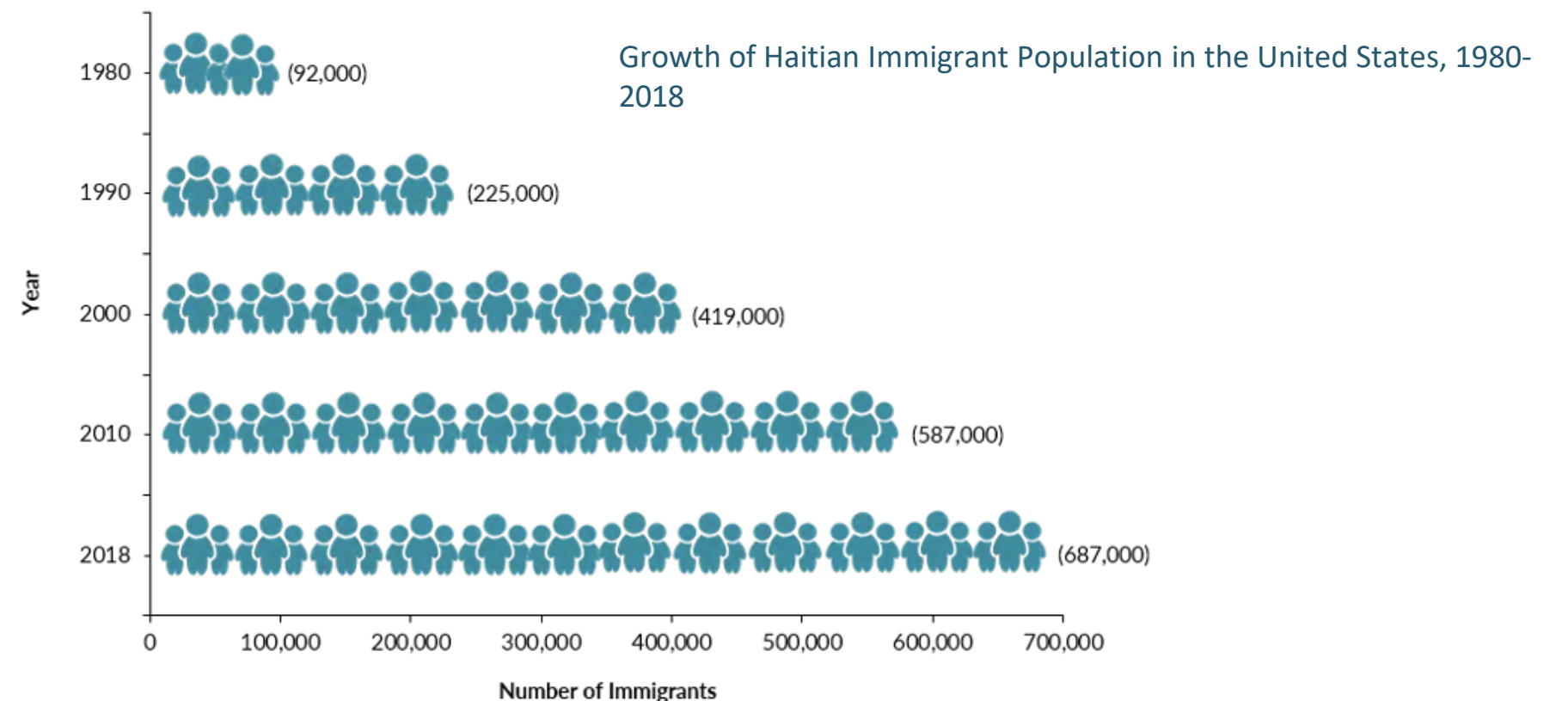

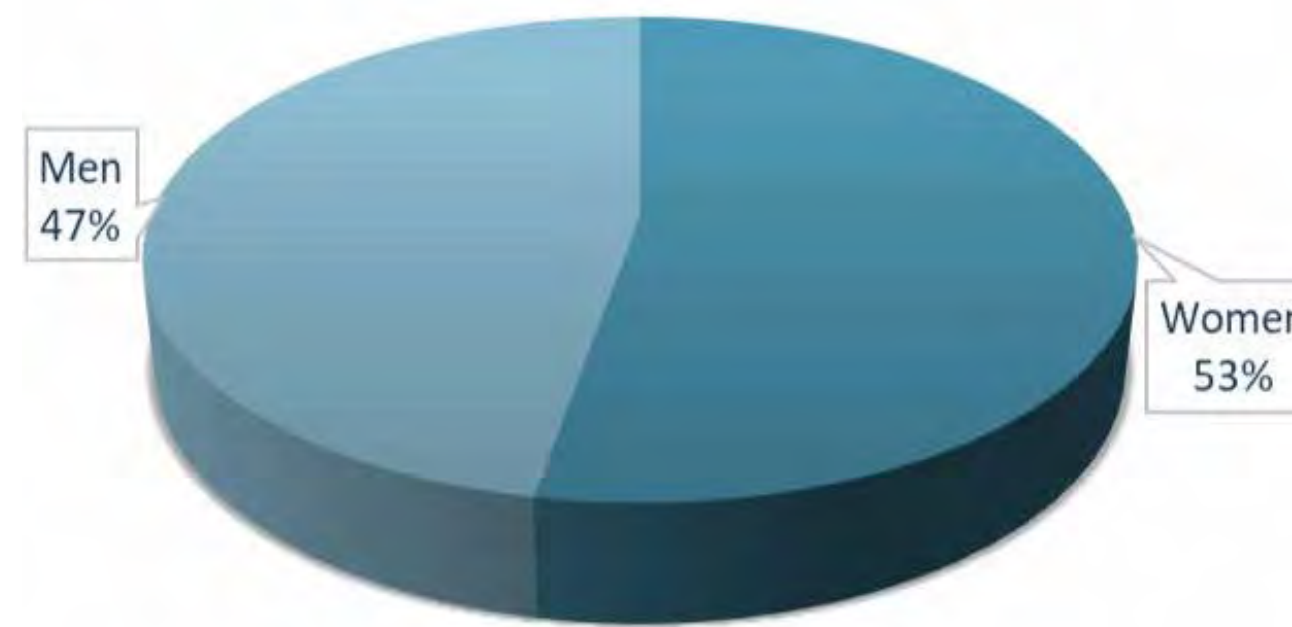

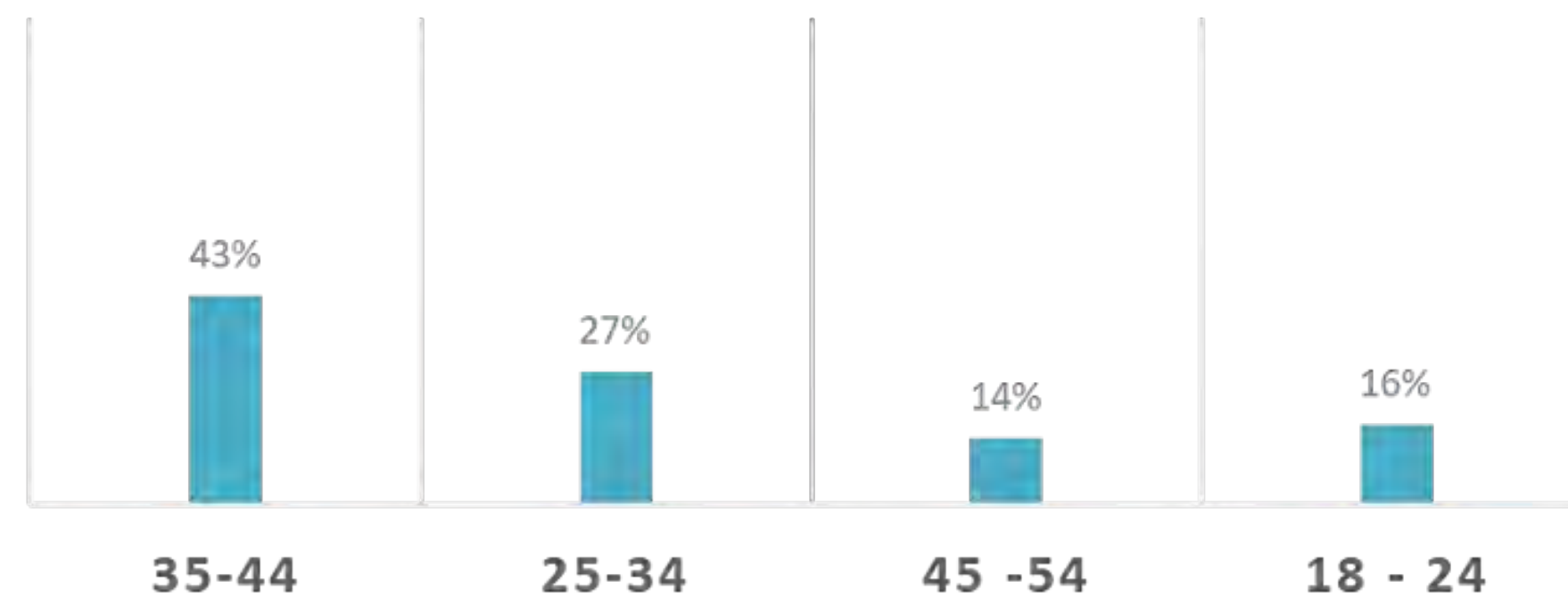
